## FEATURED TOPIC

“Gynecologic Pathology.” Saturday morning, Dr. Philip B. Clement will present several illustrative cases covering the spectrum of gynecologic pathology. Glass slides or selected photomicrographs, along with a brief clinical summary of each case, will be sent to participants prior to the symposium. During the presentation, each participant will receive a written summary of the cases along with appropriated references. Saturday afternoon, Dr. Clement will present “Serious Borderline Tumors of the Ovary: An Update.” A question and answer period will follow.

Saturday afternoon, Dr. David Booker will present “Structured Reporting in Pathology” and Dr. Hunter Hardy will present “Digital Imaging in Pathology: Where Do We Go From Here?” Medical College of Georgia faculty will present topics not related to the major topic.

Sunday morning, Drs. Clement, Rawson, Macfee, Sheils and Vartanian will present in-depth case analyses of selected areas of gynecologic pathology. Dr. Richard B. Hessler will chair this session, which will be informal and will include clinicopathologic correlations. Questions and comments from symposium participants will be encouraged.

Board of Governors Meeting / Minutes  
October 19, 2002 / Sheraton Buckhead Hotel – Atlanta, GA

**Attendees:** *Mark Hanly, MD, Anthony G. Hejka, MD, Linton Kuchler, MD, Lorraine Pare', MD, W. Charles Pfister, MD and Jerry Peloquin*

- Meeting started by its President, Dr. Hejka at approximately 7:00 A.M.
- Jerry Peloquin gave Financial and membership reports. Financially, the GAP will be going into the 2003 year with a \$5,392.50 surplus. A motion was duly made, seconded and approved to accept three new members, Drs. Christine A. Green, Edwin W. Nunnery, Jr. and Michael Dean Sennett.
- Dr. Kuchler, our MAG representative, updated the Board on MAG's current legislative interests. Tort reform has and will be of key interest to MAG in the upcoming year. MAG is planning a "March on the Capitol" November 15 to highlight "the out of control" tort system. Dr. Kuchler also mentioned that Dr. Solomon was on the GDHR Lab Advisory Committee.
- Dr. Hanly informed the Board that they were planning some type of follow-up meeting similar to the meeting hosted by his group last year titled "Weapons of Mass Destruction." Dr. Hanly said early topics of interest being discussed were molecular pathology and genetics.
- Dr. Hanly reported that Drs. Robert Baisden and David Martin attended the CAP meeting. Several Residents attended the meeting, including Drs. Dalton and Wang. Dr. Hanly will request a report from them on the meeting to be made available to the membership via the web site or newsletter.

- Dr. Hanly suggested that the GAP take a look at all current delegates/alternates and make sure that they are still interested in serving and attending the CAP meetings.
- Dr. Hanly expressed an interest in leading the GAP in the direction of taking a greater political role in the State. Several ideas were shared from Board members in attendance. Suggestions included a PAC and working more closely with MAG.
- Dr. Hanly asked that the society office start collecting email addresses of the membership for future communications.
